Our approval plan with Blackwell's regularly provides new books on selected subjects from about 1,400 North American and 600 British publishers. We are free to peruse these books and return (without penalty) any that do not meet our needs.

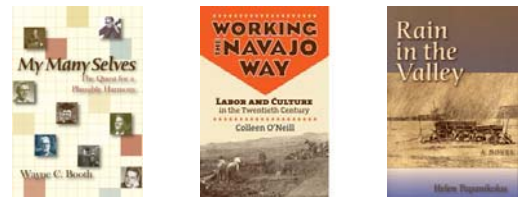

Book Acquisitions

At the Merrill-Cazier Library we spend about \$800,000 each year on books.

We acquire books in a number of ways:

- **Gifts**—donations from various sources
- **Firm orders**—books we specifically order
- **Approval plan**—books that are sent automatically for our review
- **McNaughton plan**—best sellers leased for a limited time (paid by student fees)

New books, approval books, and best sellers are all available for perusal on the 2nd floor of the Library.
