Required for Delay or Embargo

- 1. You must arrange for your Department Head to send a letter to the Dean of Graduate Studies requesting permission to delay or embargo your work submitted to ProQuest Digital Dissertations and Utah State University ETD archive.
2. The letter must include how long (up to 12 months) you want to delay or embargo your work and why you are requesting the delay or embargo. Examples: A delay for an ETD would be for publication purposes. An embargo would be for patent purposes.
