

Finding the Full Text of an Article

If an article is not available full-text in the database you are using, look for an Article Linker button or a button labeled "Check for Electronic Resources" near the citation or the summary of the article.

Check for Electronic Resources

ARTICLE LINKER

1. Click the **Article Linker** or **Check for Electronic Resources** button. A new screen will open.

2. The citation information (the information you need to locate and cite the article) will appear at the top of the screen.

3. If the article is available online in one of the library's databases, Step 1 will appear.

Check to see if the dates available include the dates for the article you need.

Click "**Article**" for the database that matches the dates you need. If the Article option is not available, click "**Journal.**" Follow the procedures for locating the full-text article in the database you chose. Each database looks and operates somewhat differently, so get help from a librarian if you need it.

4. If Step 1 does not appear, proceed to **Step Two** to locate an article in print.


a. Click **By Journal Title** to search the library catalog. In this case, the journal title is *Childhood Education*.

Type Step 2 - Search the Library Catalog:

b. The title will appear **second** on the list of results if we have a print subscription. Click the **journal title** to find out which years are available in the library.

d. The screen below will appear, showing you which years and volumes of the journal the library owns.

e. Scroll through the list of dates and volumes to see a list of all the volumes owned by the library. All journals older than one year are stored in our automated storage area, called the BARN. If you do not see a volume listed, it might be shelved in Current Journals on the Second Floor.

f. Find the volume and date you need, and click the **Request Item from BARN** link. If there is no link below the volume you need, the volume is currently checked out. Journals and magazines can be checked out for 2 days.
