

Importing Citations from EI Compendex / Engineering Village



1. From your search results, check the box next to the references you want to import into EndNote.

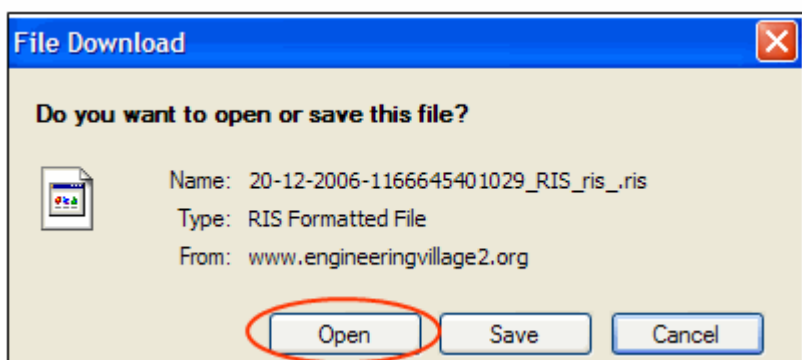
2. At the top of the page in the **Results Manager**, make sure **Citation** is selected and click **Download**.

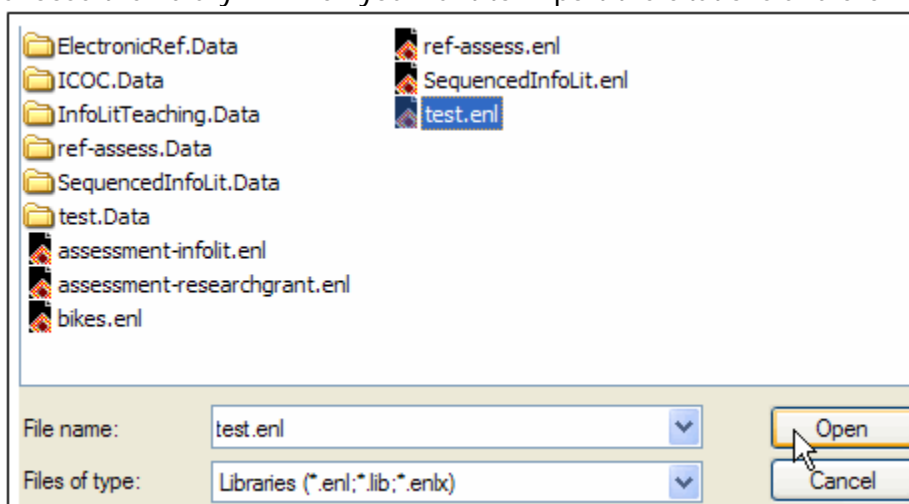
3. In the resulting dialog box, choose **RIS, EndNote, ProCite, Reference Manager** and click **Download**.

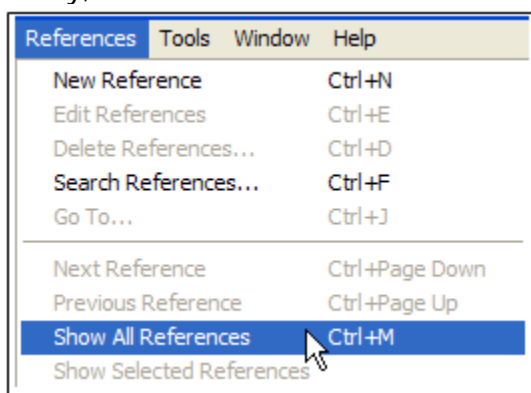
4. A dialog box will open, providing the option to Open or Save the file. Click **Open**. *Note:* the dialog box will look slightly different if you are using the Firefox web browser.



5. Choose the library in which you want to import the citations and click **Open**.



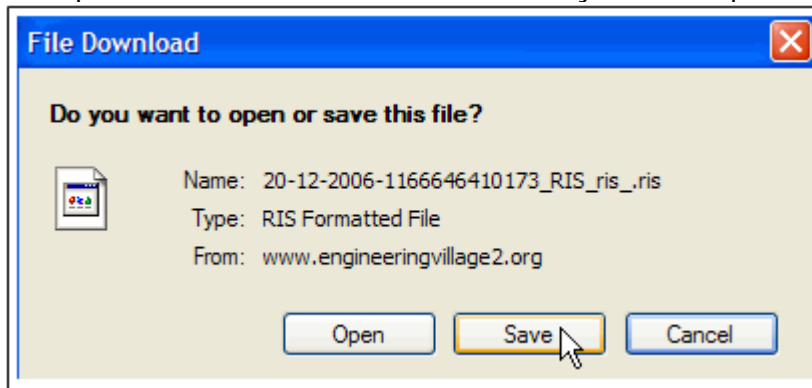
6. The citations will be imported into the selected library. To view all the citations in the library, click **References** on the menu bar and choose **Show All References**.



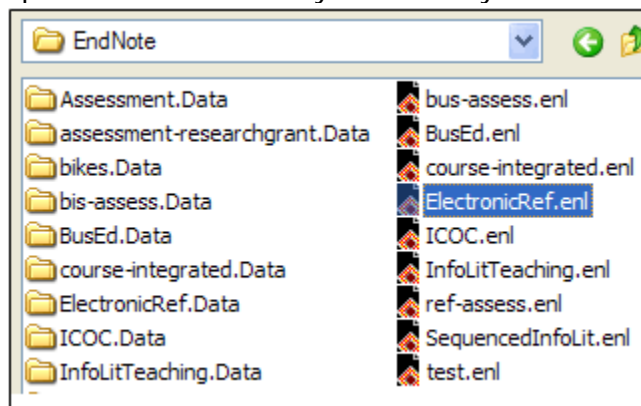
Saving a Reference File

If you choose to save the file, or if the above instructions do not work properly:

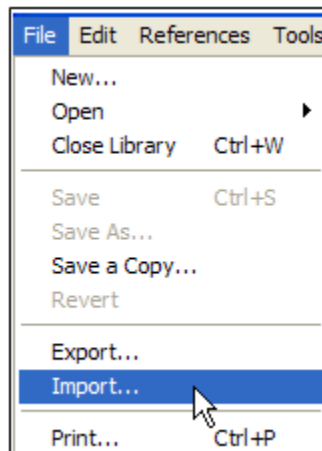
1. At step 4, choose **Save** and save the file on your desktop.



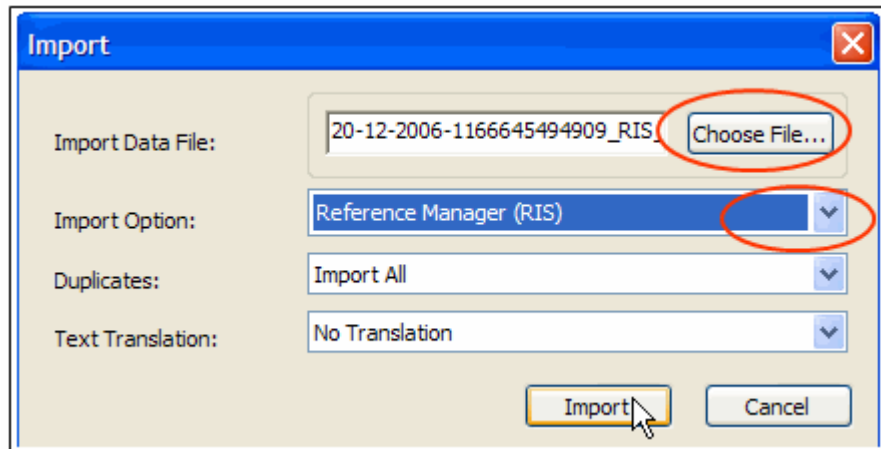
2. Open the EndNote library into which you want to put the citations.



3. Choose **File** on the menu bar and choose **Import**.



4. Click **Choose File** and select the file containing your citations from Engineering Village.



5. Via the **Import Option** drop down box, choose **RIS (Reference Manager)**. You might need to choose **Other Filters** to find this filter.
6. Click **Import** to import the references into your EndNote library.
