1. Go to the library home page: library.usu.edu.
2. From **Find Resources**, choose the **Electronic Resources & Databases** link.
3. Scroll down the page and choose the **Newspapers – Single Search** link.
4. Choose the **Historical New York Times (1851 - 2001)** link.
