As a Preservation Steward for Congressional Hearings for the Government Publishing Office's [National Collection of Government Information](#), the library ensures long-term access to physical copies of Congressional work dating from the 1890s to 2023.

Constitution Day offers the perfect opportunity to discover extensive government information resources at USU Libraries.
